Bay Minette Beautification Committee

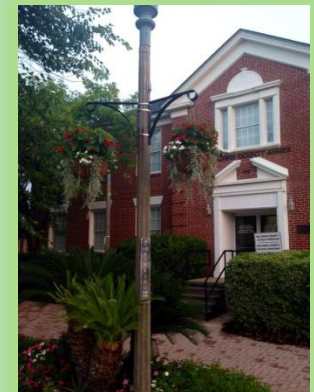
In a mission statement adopted in 2012, the Beautification Committee is dedicated to the improvement of our community.
